### **2020 CARS Late Model Stock Tour “Touring 12” Program**

The CARS Tour Late Model Stock Touring 12 is designed to create a platform to market full time LMSC regulars to the fans, media, and sponsors via a significant series based compensation package for their efforts and devotion to the series. A selection process will take place, taking in consideration the following: historic CARS Tour participation, owner/driver accomplishments, and merit to the CARS Tour both now and in the future, and ability to fulfill the signed Touring 12 agreement.

Touring 12 teams must sign an agreement to compete full time on the 2020 schedule. If selected, for their participation, all Touring 12 teams will receive the following:

- **Annual entry fees reduced to \$825, versus the total of \$1,800 if entering each even individually**
- **Guaranteed \$150 travel bonus to all CARS LMSC events in 2020**
- **The ability to purchase of two (2) sets of Hoosier tires at a discounted rate of \$100 less per set each race weekend**
- **Four (4) complimentary tickets to all CARS Tour LMSC point events**
- **Free CARS Tour attire package to wear and brand the CARS Tour**
- **Merchandise line for driver with revenue from sales going back to team (created, managed, and paid for by CARS Tour)**
- **Choice of one (1) case of water or beer at every event in 2020**
- **\$1,000 in product credit from a TBA oil/lubricant/fluid company**

#### **Requirements**

- **File a Touring 12 application via carsracingtour.com no later than February 2, 2020**
- **Complete 2020 driver registration, owner registration, and annual entry with payments in full by March 3, 2020**
- **Utilization of the driver’s name/car/likeness for all 2020 CARS Tour branding (print/social/video/etc.)**
- **Allow limited merchandising rights of driver for CARS branded driver merchandise**
- **Commit to limited driver appearances, assist with marketing ”local” events**
- **Must participate with car design in 2020 CARS Tour Throwback at HMS**

### **2020 CARS Late Model Stock Tour Three in a Row Loyalty Program**

The 2020 CARS LMSC Tour Loyalty Program is an additional incentive to compete with the tour on a regular basis if not signed to the Touring 12 program. For their attendance on a regular basis competitors will receive the following for their loyalty to the tour:

**-ANY (excluding Touring 12) TEAM who competes in ANY three (3) consecutive races will receive \$500 bonus added to their third race winnings as part of their third race purse check.**

**-Teams that are not on the Touring 12 program that compete in all ten (10) races will receive \$500 bonus added to their purse check at final race of 2020 season. With this program a team that is not a part of the Touring 12 program in 2020 and competes in all ten (10) championship points races would receive \$2,000 in cash bonus money throughout the year.**



### **2020 CARS Late Model Stock Tour “Hometown Hero Award” Program**

In 2020 CARS Tour will award drivers who are in the top three in championship points standings at their local track prior to the CARS Tour race the following in an effort to compete in the CARS Tour race at their home track:

-1<sup>st</sup> track local competitor to enter race that is a non-CARS Tour regular and sits within the track’s top three championship LMSC points standings: **3 FREE HOOSIER TIRES FOR THE FEATURE RACE**

-2<sup>nd</sup> track local competitor to enter race that is a non-CARS Tour regular and sits within the track’s top three championship LMSC points standings: **2 FREE HOOSIER TIRES FOR THE FEATURE RACE**

-3<sup>rd</sup> track local competitor to enter race that is a non-CARS Tour regular and sits within the track’s top three championship LMSC points standings: **1 FREE HOOSIER TIRE FOR THE FEATURE RACE**

### **2020 CARS Late Model Stock Tour “Bonus of Champions” Program**

The selected drivers have all won Late Model Stock Car national, state, or track championships in 2019 making them to be eligible for a \$200 cash bonus at every CARS LMSC Tour event in 2020. In order to receive the bonus, each driver and owner must have valid CARS Tour annual or single event license prior to the event, file their event entry by the deadline, and participate in promotional related duties set forth by the CARS Tour. These selected drivers are NOT eligible to be on BOTH the LMSC “Bonus of Champions” and the “Touring 12” program in 2020.
